APPLICATION FOR SCHOLARSHIP

Applicant Requirements

- 1.0 To qualify, all applicants must be either (a) a Member of NEWA who is actively employed in the wireless communications industry in New England, or (b) the child of a NEWA Member who is so actively employed. Notwithstanding the foregoing, NEWA may, in its sole discretion, deem an applicant eligible where the applicable Member has a demonstrated history of active employment in the wireless communications industry in New England but is not currently employed due to a recent layoff or similar involuntary separation. NEWA reserves the right to determine eligibility and to disqualify any applicant that NEWA determines, in its sole discretion, does not meet these qualifications.
- 2.0 All applicants must submit the required Application Form along with supporting documentation via email with required documents (*in .pdf format*) by **11:59PM on March 31st, 2026**, to newascholar@gmail.com
NOTE: *Board Members/Spouses/Children or other Relatives of current NEWA Board Members ARE NOT ELIGIBLE to apply for any scholarship awards.*
- 3.0 High School Applicants:
 - (a) Must be a graduating High School Senior currently enrolled in an accredited high school or technical school.
 - (b) Must plan to attend an accredited 2 or 4-year College/University/Community College or technical/trade/vocational school.
- 4.0 College / University Applicants:
 - (a) Must be currently enrolled in an accredited 2 or 4-year College/University/Community College or Post Graduate technical/trade/vocational school.
 - (b) Must plan to attend an accredited 2 or 4-year College/University/Community College or Post Graduate technical/trade/vocational school or current educational institution for the following academic year.
- 5.0 Professional Applicants:
 - (a) Must be a current NEWA member.
 - (b) Must plan to attend an accredited 2 or 4-year College/University/Community College or Post Graduate technical/trade/vocational school (part-time allowed) for the following academic year.
- 6.0 Personal Statement regarding Community Service / Extra Curricular Activities

Applicants should be currently engaged in donating some time to their local community, charitable organization or third-party organization contributing to community engagement projects OR involved/participating in any other after school/work extra-curricular activity or team sport. Each applicant must provide a typed statement indicating what impact their involvement in said community organization/team/activity has had on their lives and their desire to further their education. This written statement must not exceed 300 words.
- 7.0 Prior applicants and scholarship winners are eligible to apply.
